Size

One size fits most

Finished Measurements

Up to 24" in circumference and 8" deep

Yarn

allhemp3 (100% Hemp; 165yd/150m per 50g skein); 2 skeins

Needles

1 20-inch US #8/5mm circular needle
1 set of 4 US #8/5mm double-point needles
Or size necessary to obtain gauge

Gauge

4 sts and 6 rows = 1" in St st.

Notions

Stitch marker
Darning needle
Approx. 28-30" of satin ribbon

Pattern Notes

Hat is worked holding two strands of yarn together throughout.

Hemp Lace Cap

Using 5mm circular needle, CO 90 sts. Place marker and join for working in the round being careful not to twist.

Eyelet Band

Rounds 1-3: *K1, P1* around.
Round 4: *K1, P1, K2tog, YO* around.
Rounds 5-7: *K1, P1* around.
Round 8: Knit around.

Lace Body of Cap

Round 1: *YO, K3, sl1, K2tog, pssso, K3, YO, K1* around.
Round 2: Knit around.
Round 3: *K1, YO, K2, sl1, K2tog, pssso, K2, YO, K2* around.
Round 4: Knit around.
Round 5: *K2, YO, K1, sl1, K2tog, pssso, K1, YO, K3* around.
Round 6: Knit around.
Round 7: *K3, YO, sl1, K2tog, pssso, YO, K4* around.
Round 8: Knit around.

Repeat Lace rounds 1-8 until piece measures 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ " from the beginning round.

Crown

Switch to double pointed needles.
Next two rounds: *K2tog* around.

Cut yarn, leaving 8" tail. Pull through remaining stitches on double pointed needles and tighten. Sew in ends.

Finishing

Weave satin ribbon through eyelet band and tie in a bow.
