- Finished Size:** 21" in circumference and 8" deep
- Yarn:** Approximately 4 oz of your favorite worsted weight yarn
A small amount of both green and red for the cherries
and leaves
- Hook size:** 4 mm
3 mm
- Notions:** Darning needle for sewing in ends
- Skill level:** Intermediate
- Pattern notes:** Join rounds with a slip stitch to the top of the beginning
st of round unless otherwise noted.
- Ch 3 counts as first dc or the round

Stitch Guide.

bpdc – (back post double crochet) YO, insert hook from back of work to front around the vertical portion (post) of dc in the previous row, YO and draw up a loop (3 loops on hook), YO, draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops left), YO, draw through remaining two loops.

Hat

Using size 4 mm hook, Ch 4, join with a sl st to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch1, 8 sc in ring. (8 sts)

Rnd 2 – 3: Repeat round 1 (8 sts)

Rnd 4: Ch 3, 2 dc in each of next 7 dc, 1 dc in same st as joining. (16 sts)

Rnd 5: Ch 3, *1 dc in first st, 2 dc in next* repeat between asterisks around. (24 sts)

Rnd 6: Ch 3, *1 dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in next* repeat between asterisks around. (32 sts)

Rnd 7: Ch 3, *1 dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in next* repeat between asterisks around. (40 sts)

Rnd 8: Ch 3, *1 dc in next 4 sts, 2 dc in next* repeat between asterisks around. (48 sts)

Rnd 9: Ch 3, *1 dc in next 5 sts, 2 dc in next* repeat between asterisks around. (56 sts)

Rnd 10: Ch 3, *1 dc in next 6 sts, 2 dc in next* repeat between asterisks around. (64 sts)

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Rnd 11: Ch 3, *1 dc in next 7 sts, 2 dc in next* repeat between asterisks around. (72 sts)

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Rnd 12: Ch 3, *1 dc in next 8 sts, 2 dc in next* repeat between asterisks around. (80 sts)

Rnd 13: Ch 3, 1 dc in each st around. (80 sts)

Repeat round 13, 16 more times or until approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ " less than the desired hat length is reached.

Next round: ch 2, bpdC around each st of previous round.

Scalloped Edging

Ch 4, 2 dc in same chain as join, * sk 1 st, sc in next st, sk 1 st, 2 dc-ch2-2 dc in next st* repeat between asterisks to last st, sk last st, dc in same st as beginning ch 3.

Cut yarn and sew in ends.

Cherry Leaves (Make 2)

Using size 3 mm hook and green yarn, ch 11.

Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, hdc in each of next 2 ch, dc in each of next 2 ch, hdc in each on next 2 ch, sc in each of next 2 ch, ch 3 (start working down the opposite side of beginning ch). Sc in each of next 2 ch, hdc in each of next 2 ch, dc in each of next 2 ch, hdc in each of next 2 ch, sc in each of next 2 ch, join with a sl st to first sc on opposite side of ch. Ch 12 for cherry stem and leave a 8" long tail for sewing the leaves to the hat.

Cherry (Make 2)

Using red yarn, ch 2, sc in 2nd ch from hook, work 1 dc-8 tc-1 dc, 1 sc in same space as beginning sc. Leave 8" tail for sewing onto the hat. Pull on beginning tail to make the cherry tight and cherry-shaped.

Finishing

Sew on two leaves and cherries as shown in the picture below. Sew in any loose ends.
